Matter was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this court. A report has been received. Operative part whereof reads as under:-

“e) That it has been further agreed between the parties that all the accused in the above mentioned FIR shall file a petition before the Hon'ble High Court for quashing on the basis of compromise of the FIR in question as well as all the proceedings arising therefrom by 25.05.2016. Mr. Suresh Kumar-informant/complainant in the FIR undertakes to give his affidavit in support of the same to the accused and he shall come to Hon'ble High Court for compliance of the same on 21.05.2016.

f). Mr. Suresh Kumar (SPA Holder for Nidhi-Petitioner) who is the complainant/informant in the FIR mentioned above has further agreed that he

shall have no objection if the Hon'ble High Court quashes the aforesaid FIR and he undertakes to appear before the Hon'ble High Court on the date fixed and make a statement supporting the aforesaid Settlement/Agreement as well as quashing on the basis of compromise.

g). Both the parties have agreed that they shall not file any litigation against each other in future pertaining to FIR No.5 dated 10.01.2012 or Criminal Complaint No.19 of 2012.

h). Both the parties have agreed that they shall not file any criminal litigation against any of the lady member from the families of both the parties, in future.”

Learned counsel submit that both the parties shall adhered to the settlement arrived at.

In view of above, no further order needs to be passed.
