Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr. P.C.') seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.309 dated 10.07.2014, registered under Sections 307, 324, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station City Nakodar, District Jalandhar.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Addl. AG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Ms. Harpreet Kaur Arora, learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 is present before this Court and accepts notice on their behalf.

Learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 states that her clients have no objection for grant of relief of anticipatory bail prayed in this petition to the petitioners.

Learned State counsel submits that the matter is said to have been compromised after two years of the commission of offence.

Be that as it may, since the proceedings for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise are pending in CRM-M-11034 of 2016, I think the relief of anticipatory bail should be extended to the petitioners, particularly, because complainant has no objection for doing so.

In view of the above, I make the following order:

(1) In the event of arrest, petitioners shall be released on bail in FIR No.309 dated 10.07.2014, registered under Sections 307, 324, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station City Nakodar, District Jalandhar, in view of the compromise, on furnishing of their bail bonds amounting to ₹10,000/- with one surety of like amount.
