1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?
2. To be referred to the Reporters or not?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed to direct the respondent Nos.2 and 3 not to harass the petitioner and his family members. The grievance of the petitioner is that despite the fact that he is not an accused in a case he is being harassed by the police of Police Station, Julkan, District

Patiala.

Learned counsel states that at this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if he is permitted to move representation/complaint to the respondent No.2 and a direction be issued to him to look into the matter and take appropriate action on his complaint within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. Resultantly it is directed that in case the petitioner moves any representation/complaint to the respondent No.2 and it is found that any action is required, to take whatever action he deems necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
