JASPAL SINGH, J. (Oral)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of criminal complaint No. RBT 104/1 of 2011 dated 03.01.2009 titled as '*Joginderjit Kaur and another vs. Kamaljit Kaur etc.*' under Sections 420, 465, 471 read with 120-B of IPC, pending in the Court of learned JMIC, Jalandhar and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom including Summoning Order dated 16.03.2012 (Annexure P-3), on the basis of compromise dated 26.02.2016 (Annexure P-4).

2. Report of learned trial Court has been received, wherein, it has been categorically observed that the matter

has been compromised between the parties with their own free will, without any pressure and the same appears to be genuine.

3. So, in view of circumstances narrated above as well as the observations made in cases reported as ***Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another; 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052*** and ***Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another (2014) 6 SCC 466***, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for the benefit of the parties and would certainly bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and criminal complaint No. RBT 104/1 of 2011 dated 03.01.2009 titled as '*Joginderjit Kaur and another vs. Kamaljit Kaur etc.*' pending in the Court of learned JMIC, Jalandhar and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom including Summoning Order dated 16.03.2012 (Annexure P-3) are quashed qua petitioner.
