The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.1009 dated 24.12.2015 registered under
Section 420, 120-B, 467, 468 and 471 IPC at Police Station City Thanesar,
District Kurukshetra.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner-Jasbir Kaur is a woman of 84 years of age and FIR
has been registered against her. In CRM-M No.12716 of 2016 this court has
found that the real culprit is Manjit Singh who had committed fraud by
collecting signed blank papers from the file of Advocate and utilized them for

forging agreement to sell for receiving huge amounts. In so far as the present petitioners are concerned, they do not have forged anything, as such and therefore, they are entitled to grant of anticipatory bail.

In view of the above, interim order dated 28.06.2016 is made absolute.
