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ANITA CHAUDHRY, J. (ORAL)

Kiran @ Kiran Kaur and Lovedeep Singh, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 and 5 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents no.4 to 5. They have placed on record only photographs Annexures P-3 evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 23.06.2016, Annexure P-4 to respondent no.2. Marriage certificate has not been placed on record.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to approach respondent No. 2 i.e. the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar who would look into the allegation and take steps in accordance with law if situation so warrants.

This order shall not be construed to be conferring legitimacy or authenticity to the factum of marriage having been performed as the Court is clearly deprived of any means to determine the facts.
