The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking directions to the official respondents No.2 to 4 to protect their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.5 to 8 as well as their relatives.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the State states that petitioner No.1 was earlier married to respondent No.8.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners are in process of getting the earlier marriage of petitioner No.1 with respondent No.8 nullified through process of law and further states that petitioner No.2 would not marry petitioner No.1 until decree of nullity is passed by the competent court.

From the above, it is clear that there are seriously disputed questions of facts in this petition and hence the writ petition cannot be entertained.

Dismissed in view of the disputed questions of fact.
