This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.61 dated 29.05.2015 registered under Sections 302/341/148/149 IPC and Section 25/27 of Arms Act at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has not been attributed the fatal injury. However, learned Additional Advocate General states that he has also fired at the deceased and hit him below the left shoulder.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in custody for the last 14 months.

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from Investigating Officer states in case the petitioner does not obstruct the trial the prosecution will lead its entire evidence on or before 31.03.2017 and till such time the bail should not be granted to the petitioner.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, in view of the undertaking given by the learned Additional Advocate General, it is directed that in case the prosecution does not lead its entire evidence on or before 31.03.2017 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same) the petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
