FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

During the course of hearing this Court has come across an order dated 01.07.2016 whereby my learned predecessor has passed directions for depositing of Rs.5,000/- per person by the petitioners which is to be ultimately handed over to the injured by way of compensation, which to the mind of this Court can only be resorted to within the ambit of Section 457 Cr.P.C. and at this juncture it would be preposterous to make such directions. In the light of the same, directions to this effect contained in the said order are recalled.

It is submitted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh that the petitioners Dr. Jatinder Arora @ Jatin and Dr. Sukhmeet have since then joined the investigations in terms of orders of interim bail dated 01.07.2016 and nothing is to be recovered from them.

Keeping in view that being a case of simple injuries and apparently there is a professional rivalry between the petitioners who are Dentists as well as the complainant who too is running the same very profession, impels this Court to allow the petition.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 01.07.2016 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioners will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
