Petitioner is a lady who seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Pankaj Kumar alleging that his father Parkash Chand was pushed by Kedar Nath, husband of the petitioner and her son pursuant to a tenant-landlord dispute, as a result of which, father of the complainant Parkash Chand died. So far as the petitioner is concerned, as per the FIR she hurled abuses to the deceased.

Learned counsel for the complainant has intervened to oppose application for bail contending that it is the petitioner who had also pushed the deceased resulting in his death.

The culpability of the petitioner regarding homicide of deceased Parkash Chand and the intention of the petitioner will certainly be a debatable issue during trial. She being a lady, having not been attributed any role in the FIR, can be granted concession of regular bail.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

This order will not be treated as a precedent for bail to other accused in the case and the bail application of the co-accused would be decided independently, on its own merits.
