This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.45 dated 06.05.2015, under Section 304-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa, in which charges under Section 498-A IPC have also been framed by the learned trial Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has informed the Court that as per viscera report dated 05.08.2015, no poison was found in the body of the deceased.

The petitioner is in custody since 10.05.2015. As per postmortem report, there was no injury on the body of the deceased.

Heard.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and

the fact that trial may still take some time for its conclusion, this court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Mansa.
