AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from respondents No. 4 to 7.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. Petitioner No.1 in support of his age proof, has placed on record photocopy of his Adhaar Card(Annexure P-1) which depicts his date of birth as 10.11.1984. Petitioner No.2, who is a foreign citizen, in support of her age proof has also placed on record photocopy of her Birth Certificate(Annexure P-2) which shows her date of birth as 10.11.1979. They have already moved a representation before the

Superintendent of Police, Yamunanagar for protecting their life and liberty.

Copy of the representation is annexed as Annexure P-6.

Reply has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 along with the statements of the parties wherein they have stated that they have no threat of any kind from the respondents and they do not need any protection. The petitioners are present as are respondents No.4 and 5 are present. They have stated that they have no objection to the marriage. Even otherwise learned DAG also states that the police will consider the representation of the petitioners.

In the circumstances, without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Yamunanagar-respondent No.2 to take an appropriate action on the said representation.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.

A copy of this order be given dasti to learned counsel for the petitioners on payment of usual charges.
