Heard learned Counsel for the rival parties. The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.130 dated 16.5.2013, under Sections 451, 323, 506, 509 IPC, PS Bawa Khel, District Jalandhar on the basis of compounding/compromise. Pursuant to the order dated 12.10.2015, report of the learned JMIC, Jalandhar has been received who has recorded the statements of the parties and reported that the compromise has been effected voluntarily, without any pressure or coercion. In that view of the matter, the petition is allowed and the impugned FIR, along with all consequential proceedings, is quashed by way of compounding/ compromise.
