A.B. CHAUDHARI, J (Oral)

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to protect her life and liberty from the hands of respondents No.6 to 12.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner got married to Natha Ram son of Darshan Ram in the year 2004. Natha Ram used to live abroad. On 21.04.2016, Hans Raj-Dewar (brother-in-law) of the petitioner hit Sandeep Kumar son of Mohinder Pal with his car. Sandeep Kumar received injuries and accordingly FIR No.26 dated 21.04.2016 under Sections 279, 337 and 506 IPC was registered as Police Station Mukandpur, District SBS Nagar against Hans Raj. Hans Raj got registered a cross-case against Sandeep Kumar and others. Hans Raj along with some other persons gave injuries to Mohinder Pal and some other persons due to which they got lodged a complaint against Hans Raj and others. In-laws of the petitioner pressurized her to make

false statement against Sandeep Kumar and others in order to implicate them in false case, to which she refused. Due to this, in-laws of the petitioner got angry and threatened to kill her and her minor son. In this regard, the petitioner has moved a representation to Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Annexure P-3), but no action has been taken so far.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar, respondent No.2 is directed to look into the representation (Annexure P-3) moved by petitioner and if required, take necessary remedial measure.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
