The petitioner is involved in a case of smuggling of intoxicating material from Pakistan. He is alleged to have been a member of gang of Ranjit Singh. On the basis of recovery having been effected from one Gurminder Singh i.e. 9 Kg 600 grams of heroin, the investigation had been taken in hand. So far as petitioner is concerned he was neither found in actual physical possession of any intoxicating substance nor there is allegation against him of having found in actual possession of any contraband. He is in custody w.e.f. 13.5.2014. Ranjit Singh has been granted concession of bail in the present case.

Carefully perusing the allegation against the petitioner, he can be charged for an offence under Section 29 of the NDPS Act. Challan against the petitioner has already been presented. Similarly circumstanced co-accused have been granted the concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the conditions that the petitioner will not commit any similar offence of which he is accused of during the entire period of the trial.
