Heard Learned Counsel for the rival parties. Admittedly, initially the offences under Sections 147, 149, 323, 506 IPC were registered. In this view of the matter, since the petitioner has joined the investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency, order dated July 01, 2016 is made absolute.
