Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondents No.4 to 10.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the marriage of the petitioners was solemnized on 25.06.2016. Photographs of marriage ceremony are annexed as Annexure P-4. Marriage certificate issued by Gurudwara Shahid Baba Jiwan Singh (Regd.) Village Chhibranwali (Sri Muktsar Sahib), Punjab is annexed as Annexure P-3. Learned counsel has further submitted that the petitioners have moved a representation to Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib (Annexure P-5), but no action has been taken so far.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, respondent No.2 is directed to look into the representation (Annexure P-5) moved by petitioners and if required, necessary protection be provided to them.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
