By virtue of instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., Manish @ Tinku has sought bail in case FIR No. 529, dated October 08, 2015, under Sections 392, 397, 420, 467, 468, 471 of IPC and 25 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Kundli, District Sonapat, Haryana.

The instant case stands registered on the basis of a complaint dated October 08, 2015 lodged by Ram Singh unfolding that on October 07, 2015 some unidentified persons took away his Scorpio vehicle No.HR-29-AD-8377. The petitioner was arrested in another case bearing FIR NO. 459, dated October 17, 2015, under Sections 392, 395 and 412 IPC. It is alleged that during investigation of that case, the petitioner suffered disclosure

statement admitting his guilt and further that on the date of occurrence, he along with Sham @ Sittu and Manish @ Golu had snatched the aforesaid Scorpio. Though, petitioner was subjected to custodial interrogation but nothing incriminating was recovered from him. However, Scorpio was recovered from his co-accused Manish @ Golu. After completion of the investigation, challan has already been presented and now the case is listed for prosecution evidence.

In the given circumstances, disposal of the trial is likely to take considerable time and this Court is of the considered view that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars for an indefinite period.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspects of the matter, instant petition stands allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of trial Court.
