Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.109 dated 11.8.2015 under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 307 and 308 IPC (already deleted vide DDR No.17 dated 17.3.2016) registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 8.7.2016 of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and submits that the custody of the petitioner is no more required.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custody is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 8.7.2016 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
