The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.52 dated 16.09.2015, for the offence under Sections 363/366-A IPC registered at Police Station Ghanie Ke Bangar, Police Station Batala, District Gurdaspur, along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom against the petitioner.

As per allegation in the FIR, petitioner had ran away along with the daughter of the complainant by inducement on the pretext of marriage. On the basis of this background, FIR was registered (Annexure P-1).

On issuing notice, reply has been filed by way of affidavit of Harisharan Sharma, PPS, DSP, Fatehgarh Churian, Police District Batala, on behalf of respondent No.1 stating therein that Karamjit Kaur-daughter of the complainant who was 17 years and 11 months at the time of incident had accompanied to the petitioner and solemnized marriage on 14.10.2015 and both residing peacefully and enjoying married happy life in the house of the petitioner.

Accordingly, no ground is made out for further proceedings in the matter and FIR No.52 dated 16.09.2015, for the offence under Sections 363/366-A IPC registered at Police Station Ghanie Ke Bangar, Police Station Batala, District Gurdaspur, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioner.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
