This is a petition preferred by the petitioner-Hakmu under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail in case FIR No. 365, dated May 30, 2016, under Sections 420, 467, 471, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 55, District Faridabad (Haryana).

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on July 04, 2016:-

“Heard.

2. Notice to the Advocate General, Punjab for 08.08.2016.

3. In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join the investigation.

In the event of arrest, petitioner shall be released on pre-arrest bail at the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer subject to the conditions, as envisaged under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

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In pursuance of order dated July 04, 2016, passed by this Court, petitioner has already joined the investigation but the learned State counsel has submitted that petitioner is not co-operating as he is not giving his handwriting/signatures for the comparison purpose. Moreover, petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer as and when desired by him and to give his handwriting/signatures for the comparison purpose within a period of 10 days from today and the Investigating Officer shall get the needful done.

Taking into consideration the above facts of the case, interim order dated July 04, 2016 is made absolute, subject to the conditions, as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
