This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C  
for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 19 dated  
2.3.2016 under Sections 489-A, 489-B, 489-C, 489-D and 120-B IPC at  
Police Station Sekhwan, District Gurdaspur.

As per the FIR there are allegation against the  
petitioner that there is recovery of huge amount of counterfeit currency  
notes as well as printer.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has undergone custody for a period of six months.

Ms. Amarjit Kaur Khurana, Additional Advocate General, Punjab., on instructions from the ASI accepts these factual assertions and states that it would be more appropriate to put a time cap on the trial. The prosecution will conclude its entire evidence within two months subject to the accused not obstructing the same.

In the circumstances, the present petition is dismissed.

The trial court is directed to release the petitioner on bail on 27.10.2016, in case the prosecution does not conclude its entire evidence subject to the accused not obstructing the same.
