Pursuant to order dated December 22, 2015, report has been received from the trial court. Operative part thereof reads as under:-

"I have the honour to submit that the statement in above noted case could not be recorded because complainant/Victim i.e. Sh. Rajbir Singh S/o Surat Singh & Ashok Kumar S/o Sh. Ram Nath had not appeared before the court. Efforts were made by the undersigned & summons issued to complainant Rajbir Singh S/o Sh. Surat Singh received back with the report that he used to live on the address as tenant and he has left the house around two years back. In the absence of any other address of complainant/Victim, his presence could not be secured. Summons issued to Ashok S/o Sh. Ram Nath also received back with the report that House is locked so presence of Ashok Kumar S/o Ram Nath could not be secured & statement could not be recorded due to not turning

up of complainant/Victims. Therefore, in the absence of statement of complainant/Victim, the report qua genuineness of compromise, if any could not be given.”

In view of above, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that she may be allowed to withdraw this petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
