This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.3 dated 20.01.2016, registered under Sections 406,420,120-B IPC, at Police Station Lambran, District Jalandhar (Punjab)

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in custody since 11.02.2016 and the main accused is Madan Lal, who had taken money from the complainant to send him abroad.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from Sub

Inspector Satpal has accepted this factual assertion.

Keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
