Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the marriage of the petitioners was solemnized on 30.06.2016. Photographs of marriage ceremony are annexed as Annexure P-3. Learned counsel has further submitted that the petitioners have moved a representation to Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural), Punjab (Annexure P-4), but no action has been taken so far.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar, District Jalandhar, respondent No.2, is directed to look into the representation (Annexure P-4) moved by petitioners and if required, necessary protection be provided to them. Liberty is further granted to the petitioners to approach the Sessions Court within a period of seven days from today.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
