The petitioner is seeking direction to the respondents to conduct fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.0042 dated 06.06.2016, under Sections 294, 376, 452, 506, 509 IPC, registered at Police Station, Women, Ambala.

Upon notice, reply on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3, in the shape of affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police, Ambala, has been filed in Court. Same is taken on record. As per this reply, initial investigation of the case was conducted by Inspector Amarjeet Kaur, SHO, Women Police Station, Ambala and statement of the petitioner was got recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C. on 07.06.2016. On 19.08.2016, Surinder Kumar was joined in the investigation. During investigation, he admitted that on 21.05.2016, he had consumed excess liquor and entered the

house of Jaswinder Kaur-petitioner and forcibly committed rape upon her. After his arrest, Surinder Kumar disclosed that 5/6 months ago, there was a quarrel between him and the petitioner. Thereafter, Sections 201/211 IPC were added in the case. His disclosure statement was recorded on 20.08.2016. Now, Surinder Kumar is in judicial custody.

In view of the aforesaid reply, no further orders are required to be passed in this petition as investigation is already going on.

Disposed of accordingly.
