This is a petition for regular bail filed in case bearing FIR No.53 dated 26.04.2015 registered under Sections 22 NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station PS Cantt., District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has been in custody since February, 2016.

Learned State counsel has stated that two out of five witnesses have already been examined and the prosecution undertakes to conclude its entire evidence within a period of three months subject to the petitioner not obstructing the same.

Resultantly, it is directed that in case the prosecution does not conclude its entire evidence till 22.12.2016 as stated above (subject to the petitioner not obstructing the same), the trial court shall release the petitioner on bail to its satisfaction.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the Criminal Misc.
Application, if any, also stands disposed off.
