Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking directions to respondents No. 1 to 4 to decide the complaint (Annexure P-1) dated 18.06.2016 made to respondents No. 3 and 4 in accordance with law.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 4 only.

3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Parveen Aggarwal, DAG, Haryana has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though complaint/representation dated 18.06.2016 (Annexure P-1) was moved to

respondent No.4 but till date no action has been taken.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3- Deputy Commissioner of Police-cum-Senior Superintendent of Police, Panchkula, to inquire into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his complaint/representation dated 18.06.2016 (Annexure P-1) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
