This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuing directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to take appropriate legal action on the representation (Annexure P-1) made by the petitioners against respondents No. 5 to 8.

As per the allegations contained in a petition three married women all living in separate houses were stopped by the private respondents and attempts were made to outrage their modesty. The petitioners plead that separate representations have been given but no action was taken and pressure was exercised to withdraw the complaints.

On the last date of hearing the petitioners were asked to place on record the postal receipts to show that the complaints had been sent. The postal receipts have not been placed on record but an affidavit has been filed to state that the representation was sent and was received vide Diary No. 49-D/PSOC dated 08.04.2016. A perusal of the representation shows that the petitioners/applicants did not give their own address. It would not be possible for the police officer to entertain the complaint when the address or the contact numbers have not been given.

No directions are required to be passed.

The petition is dismissed.
