Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case registered by way of FIR No.346 dated 21.12.2014 at Police Station City Ferozepur under Sections 454/380/427 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 08.07.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined investigations and nothing has been recovered from them which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhmander Singh who submits that the petitioners are no longer required for further investigation and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 08.07.2016 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioners will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
