For the reasons set out in the application, same is allowed as prayed for and amended Head Note & Amended Prayer Clause are allowed to be taken on record. Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.147 dated 12.05.2016, registered under Sections 323, 324, 34 IPC and Section 12 of POCSO Act (Section 506/325/354-A IPC added later on), Police Station Rania, District Sirsa.

The counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations are that Rajbir had given a danda blow and the injury at the most would fall under Section 324 IPC. The counsel urges that there was a love affair

between the son of the petitioner and the prosecutrix and she had been writing letters to him.

The State counsel urges that the petitioner had given a Dattar blow on the head of Rajat. The counsel urges that the victim who is 17 years old made a statement that the son of the petitioner was pursuing her and in case she did not agree he had threatened to throw acid on her and when the parents went to the house of the petitioner they were attacked and a Dattar blow was given and there is swelling on the occipital region. The State counsel also urges that recovery of the weapon is to be effected.

The counsel for the petitioner states that the injuries were received by them but the police did not register any case.

Considering the allegations and the fact that the recovery is to be effected and custodial interrogation would be required, no case for bail is made out. The petition is dismissed.
