The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 31.01.2015 in a case registered on the basis of secret information that the petitioner was involved in smuggling of narcotic drugs and could be apprehended while coming on tractor and a swift car along with accomplice. The petitioner was apprehended along with two other persons sitting on the tractor from whom 3 kg and 2 kg of heroin were recovered. The driver of the swift car allegedly escaped and fled away from the nakabandi.

On asking of the Court, it has been informed that no recovery has been effected from the possession of the petitioner and he has been charged under Section 29 for abetment of the offence.

Taking into consideration the totallity of the circumstances; the period of detention of the petitioner and the status of the trial, no witness having been examined, this petition is allowed. It is ordered

that the petitioner will be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that he will not indulge in the similar activity of which he is accused of during the pendency of the trial.
