Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.98 dated 15.06.2015 under Sections 307, 452, 324, 323 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Kurali, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Kesar Singh, states that so far as claim of the petitioner seeking parity with co-accused Hardev Singh is concerned, the same is not maintainable as Hardev Singh was granted regular bail, whereas the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of present petition, however, with liberty to approach the

trial Court to seek regular bail. He further prays that the trial Court may be directed to decide the bail application expeditiously.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

It is made clear that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court and moves an application seeking regular bail, the trial Court shall decide the same expeditiously.
