For having been found in possession of 100 gms. of intoxicating powder which on analysis was found to contain dyphenoxylate hydro chloride, the petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 25.5.2016. She was released on interim bail till the receipt of report of chemical examiner.

Report of chemical examiner having now been received, the petitioner was taken in custody.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is a lady who has been falsely implicated.

State counsel on the basis of record and information supplied by ASI Vijay Kumar, informs that the petitioner is involved in 11 more cases of similar nature.

No ground is made out to grant the concession of bail to the petitioner.

The petition is dismissed. However, it is observed that in case the trial is not concluded within a period of six months after the next date of hearing fixed before the trial Court, it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again for the grant of bail.
