Through instant petition preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioners have sought directions to respondents to hand over the investigation of cross case under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC registered in FIR No.193, dated 24.07.2015, under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC, at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar City to some senior IPS officer or Crime Branch, Punjab Chandigarh.

2. Notice of motion to the respondents-State only, at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.

4. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioners is that though representation dated 12.05.2016 (Annexure P-6) was moved to respondent No.2 but till date no substantive action has been taken.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their representation dated 12.05.2016 (Annexure P-6) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
