Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Prince Pal Singh in case FIR No.101 dated 20.11.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 323, 452, 380 and 34 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Nurmahal, District Jalandhar City.

As per allegations in the FIR, petitioner along with other accused persons on 20.11.2015 has forcibly entered the house of the complainant and caused injuries on his person and also committed theft of Rs.3000/-.

It is contended that the petitioner is attributed only one injury with *Datar* on the wrist and backside of the forehead, which was not

grievous.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel assisted by ASI Anwar Masih submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 16th of February, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
