Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking direction to respondent No.3 to act upon the representations dated 28.01.2016 and 03.05.2016 (Annexures P-3 and P-4) moved by the petitioner with further prayer to take action against private respondents.

2. Notice of motion to official respondents only.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Parveen Aggarwal, DAG, Haryana has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in

case direction is given to Superintendent of Police to inquire into the grievances of the petitioner and take appropriate action.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3- Superintendent of Police, Sirsa to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 28.01.2016 (Annexure P-3) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
