Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking appropriate order or direction to transfer the investigation of the case to some senior police officer or some independent investigation agency, for getting the same conducting in a fair and impartial manner and further directing the official respondent to speed up the investigation and complete the same in a time bound manner.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3.

3. On the asking of Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though representation dated 20.06.2016 (Annexure P-2) was moved to respondent No.2 but till date no action has been taken.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case direction is given to Senior Superintendent of Police to inquire into the grievances of the petitioner and take appropriate action.

6. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala, to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 20.06.2016 (Annexure P-2) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
