This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.61 dated 09.04.2016 registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 427, 307 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54 and 59 of Arms Act at Police Station Sector 11, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the injuries attributed to the petitioner are simple in nature and the petitioner is in custody since 08.04.2016.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Ramesh Kumar submits that the petitioner is heavily involved in campus violence and next month the student council election of Punjab University are stated to be held and there is apprehension that the petitioner's release may escalate the violence quotient.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner may be granted bail subject to any condition which the Court may impose.

In the circumstances, keeping in view the nature of injuries attributed to the petitioner, the period of custody already suffered by

him and without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny him the concession of bail.

Bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Chandigarh subject to the condition that the petitioner shall mark his presence in the police station concerned on every Monday till 21.12.2016.

Petition stands disposed of.
