This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 86 dated 08.06.2016, under Sections 498-A, 304-B, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Nangal, District Rupnagar, Punjab.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Madan Lal, has informed the Court that after conducting an enquiry, it has been transpired that husband of the deceased was having an affair with one girl namely, Neha. This fact has come out after recording call details of the husband of deceased namely Deepak Sharma. She has further informed that during enquiry, the petitioner has been declared innocent and the enquiry report is pending approval of the SSP concerned. The petitioner is no longer required

for investigation.

In view of the said fact, this petition has become infructuous.
