This order shall dispose of CRM Nos. M-21638 & M-26788 of 2015 as both these petitions have been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.299 dated 6.10.2014 under sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 307, 302, 201 I.P.C and sections 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station, Sadar Ballabgarh, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

It is a case, where an occurrence took place on 5.10.2014 and in which three lives were lost namely Indraj, Mohan Lal and Bharat Pal.

Injuries are attributed to the present petitioners on the person of deceased

Indraj.

Even though, the present petitioners are stated to have faced incarceration since October/November, 2014 but keeping in view the serious allegations and gravity of the offence, this Court is not inclined to grant to the petitioners the concession of bail, at this stage.

Such view is being taken without going into the merits of the case and against the status of trial that has been furnished by learned State counsel, wherein it is stated that only official witnesses remain to be examined.

Both these connected petitions are disposed of with a direction to the Trial Court to expedite the trial and in any case conclude the same within a period of three months from today.

Petitions disposed of.
