JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking directions to register FIR as per the allegation contained in the representation dated 18.05.2015 (Annexure P-1) and further after the registration of the case, the investigation of the case be handed over to some independent agency for investigation.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 4.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner while referring to the

photographs and representations submits that though representation/complaint was moved to Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran on 18.05.2015 but till date no action has been taken against the culprits.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner feels satisfied, in case, direction is given to Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to enquire into the allegations unfolded in representation dated 18.05.2015 (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate action.

6. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 18.05.2015 (Annexure P-1) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
