Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.33 dated 8.6.2016, under Sections 420 and 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Satnampura, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that earlier a dispute between the parties was pending and the brother of petitioner No.1-Sandeep had lodged an FIR No.817 dated 20.11.2014, under Sections 406, 420, 120-B, 109 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Thanesar City, District Kurukshetra against respondent No.2-Gurmeet Singh. Similarly, petitioner No.2-Inderjeet Singh also filed a criminal complaint (MACT) No.13 of 2015, Date of Institution 06.1.2015, titled 'Inderjeet Singh vs. Rameshwar Dass and others', on the same set of allegations as referred in FIR No.817dated 20.11.2014.

Since the FIR in question was registered only on 8.6.2016 and the petitioner approached this Court on 17.6.2016, it is presumed that the police must be investigating the matter.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition, however, seeks liberty to take all the pleas as available during the course of investigation.

Dismissed as not pressed with the liberty aforesaid.
