Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner on the basis of threat perception from one Balwant Singh Ramoowalia, who is real brother of the husband of the petitioner.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3.

3. On the asking of Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though complaint/application dated 17.05.2016 (Annexure P-5) was moved but till date

no action has been taken.

The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana, to inquire into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her complaint/application dated 17.05.2016 (Annexure P-5) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
