Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

This is application for transfer the case from one court to another.

These cases relate to the year 2014 in relation to the bouncing of cheque.

Learned Sessions Judge observed that the application has been made at stage of Section 313 Cr.PC. i.e. recording of the statement of the accused.

The learned Sessions Judge also observed that the applications were filed only for delaying the disposal of the case. The petitioner ought to have filed the application for consolidation or transfer of the case at initial stage. No fault can be found out with the impugned order.

In this view of the matter I do not find any substance in the petition. Accordingly the petition is dismissed.
