JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. to handover the investigation of FIR No.104 dated 31.12.2014, registered under Section 3 (xiii) of Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, Sections 341, 323, 506 IPC at Police Station Tarsikka, District Amritsar to an independent agency and further direction to form/constitute a Special Investigating Team (SIT) so as to ensure free, fair, impartial and expeditious investigations.

At the very outset of arguments, it has been submitted by learned State counsel, on instructions ASI

Prabhjinder Singh, that the investigation in this case is complete and the cancellation report/final report is likely to be presented within a period of fortnight.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel no further action is required to be taken. The petition has rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of accordingly.

However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to take all the pleas taken in this petition in the protest petition or in the complaint, if any, to be filed by him.
