Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Prince Chug in case registered by way of FIR No.147 dated 03.06.2016 at Police Station Sector 18, Gurgaon under Section 420 IPC and Sections 63/65 of the Copyright Act, 1957.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Suresh Kumar, Police Station Phase-I, Gurgaon submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 11.07.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations and that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 11.07.2016 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
