This is a petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondents for expeditious conclusion of investigation and presentation of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. in FIR No. 313, dated October 21, 2015, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 511 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 31, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though various representations (Annexures P-7 to P-12) have been made to respondents No.2 & 3 to conclude the investigation as early as possible, but till date no action has been taken by the concerned authorities.
