M.M.S. BEDI, JUDGE (ORAL)

Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Sant Kumar, Constable alleging that he was abducted by four persons in a car on 14.06.2014. So far as the petitioner is concerned, the allegation against him is that he had cheated 310 constables of ITBP by giving them forged orders of High Court and was having grudge against the complainant who led the aggrieved constables.

So far as the allegation in the present FIR are concerned, the only allegation against the petitioner is that he conspired with other accused and got him abducted.

Without expression of any opinion on merits in other cases or the culpability of the petitioner in those cases, it is sufficient to observe here that petitioner has been in custody in the present case with effect from 12.02.2016.

Learned counsel for the complainant has intervened to inform this Court that the complainant has compromised the matter with the petitioner regarding which the State counsel has got no instructions from the investigating officer.

Taking into consideration the totality of the above circumstances, challan having already been presented, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail. Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in FIR No. 194 dated 16.06.2015 under Sections 328, 363, 365, 120B of IPC registered at Police Station Dahka, Ludhiana, on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court and he will be released, in case, not required in any other case.
