Prayer is under Section 439 Cr.PC for grant of regular bail to the petitioner Dalip Kumar in case FIR No.99 dated 01.04.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 21B/22/27A/61/85 of the NDPS Act registered with Police Station City Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa.

There is alleged recovery of 219 bottles of Rexcof Syrup, which as per FSL report dated 1.7.2015 has been found to contain Codeine and Chlorphineramine. Thus concededly the quantity is commercial in nature.

It is contended that the petitioner is in custody since 01.04.2015 and there are 21 cited witnesses.

Learned State Counsel assisted by ASI Prem Kumar concedes that the evidence of the prosecution is yet to commence.

In the light of the seized quantity being commercial in nature, learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

It is hoped that efforts would be made to conclude the prosecution evidence within three months from today.
